A Benefit Night was held for the Albert and Marcia Jedlicka family on Friday April 20, 2018 from 6-10:00pm. The family had a house fire which completely ruined the whole interior of the house with smoke and water damage. Albert, an active member of The Knights of Columbus, was also off of work for several weeks because of a knee injury so a lot of medical bills incurred at the time. The Knights headed up the benefit organizing a steak feed plus silent and live auctions. The Knights asked the Fire Department Board for the use of their building and Cargill Beef Solutions, Albert's employer, to Co-Sponsor the event. Cargill donated 300 lbs of steaks and 100 lbs of hamburger and the use of their grill for the feed. The Knights planned for a maximum of 300 people and thought that was way more than would attend. How wrong they were! The crowd was overwhelming with an estimate of more than 600 attending. Luckily, Jeff Didier, a member Knight and owner of Didiers Grocery was at the benefit so he and some of his employees were able to provide enough extra food to feed the extra number of people. All the Knights of the Council were asked to provide deserts for the event. Music was donated and provided by Joe Cockson from 7-9:00 pm. Over 50 items were donated for the silent auction and collected by Brother Knights plus many items for the live auction. The Auctions netted over \$8,000. The other \$14,000 was donated by those walking through the door for a steak. Flyers (see attached) were distributed throughout the surrounding communities as well as newspaper articles and radio announcements. The menu included Ribeye and Hamburger Steaks, hashbrown casserole, macaroni salad, rolls and deserts.

This was truly an example of KNIGHTS IN ACTION. Over 100 Knights helped to take tickets at the door, Grill the steaks, Deliver the steaks to the kitchen, serve the meals at the bazaar line, clean tables, work the live and silent auction, prepare the food, plus write and distribute flyers.
