




Online Membership is only available to residents of the United States or Canada. Residents outside of these countries must click the circled link.






- An applicant can choose to use an Agent Referral Code OR a Promo Code, but not both.
- The two boxes circled in RED must be checked to submit the application.






- If there is a preferred local council, you can enter its number and the number of the member who referred you (See the blue box).
- Like the two boxes shown on the previous slide, the box next to the statement circled in RED much be checked to submit the application.

Online Membership and Councils

- Online members belong to state divisions
 - Under the jurisdiction of the state council.
- Online members can convert to local council membership
- Councils receive membership credit when an online member converts to a local council.
 - Dues Adjustments will be processed by Council Accounts
- States and councils are notified through reports and email when a member expresses interest in joining locally.



Transferring Online Members to Local Councils

- Online Members should be voted on the same way a new member would be
- Online Members must go through the ceremonial before being transferred
- You can transfer Online Members via Form 100 or using Member Management




Transferring Online Members

- After prospects are assigned by the state officer, they can be viewed by your council in your prospect tab
- The tab will ONLY be seen by Grand Knights and Financial Secretaries



Council Officers - How It Works



- Add the Ceremonial Date
- Hit Transfer



Transferring Online Members

- There is NO NEED to submit a form 100 when using this method
- Councils will receive +1 when an online member transfers into a local council



Email to State Deputy, Membership Director, Grand Knight & Financial Secretary when "Preferred Council" is entered.

Remember: Men who join online are Knights that have not taken their First Degree. They will need to undergo the Exemplification of Charity, Unity and Fraternity to join a local council.

Councils and states both receive quota credit when members convert from online state divisions to local councils.

To Register:

- 1. Go to the registration page: https://stage.knights.net/req
- 2. Enter your invitation code, membership number, council/division number, and email you used when joining online.
- 3. Create a Username and Password.
- 4. Enter a password reminder in case you forget your Password.
- 5. Enter your Secret Answers, which are required when changing your Password.
- 6. Click "Submit"
