### A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE PROGRAM

The Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose Program began in 1960 as a project of the Knights of Columbus Columbian Squires of North America to honor the

Blessed Virgin under her title of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas. The program has continued since then as a project in most Knights of Columbus jurisdictions.

From early March through mid-December, Silver Roses are stewarded

by Knights of Columbus councils along routes from Canada to Mexico. Every stop the Silver Rose makes throughout the pilgrimage is a rosary-centered occasion for Knights, parishioners and community members to pray for respect for life, for the spiritual renewal of each nation, and for the advancement of the message of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

A Silver Rose "honoring Our Lady of Guadalupe and reaffirming our commitment to the sanctity of human life" is carried by Knights from Canada, through the United States, and into Mexico to arrive at the Basilica in Monterrey, Mexico on December 12, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. ### ARRIVAL IN NEBRASKA

Conditions permitting, the Silver Rose will arrive in Nebraska from Colorado on August 16, 2021, and continue to cross our state. We'll pass it on September 12, 2021. The location of the Rose entering and leaving Nebraska has not yet been determined.



### One Rose One Life Campaign:

- State—run program where all funds must be submitted to the State
   Culture of Life Foundation
- All funds collected will be used to support pro life organizations and activities throughout Nebraska
- A major objective of the Culture of Life Foundation is t place ultrasounds in qualified pregnancy care centers throughout Nebraska. To date, we have helped purchase fifteen ultrasound machines
- Many organizations benefit form this campaign too such as the Nebraska Catholic Conference, local Right-to-Life and Birthright Chapters and crisis pregnancy-help centers throughout the state



#### **NEBRASKA CULTURE OF LIFE ACTIVITIES**

#### ONE ROSE ONE LIFE CAMPAIGN

#### Making a difference:

- Choose a weekend for your campaign, usually around the anniversary of Roe vs Wade January decision that legalized abortions on January 22, 1973
- Pick a motivated chairman to do chair this event
- Do pulpit announcements and place flyers in your bulletins, distribute the annual Nebraska Knights of Columbus Prayer cards at the event(s), collect funds get permission to do a second collection
- Publicize a thank you note in your parish and community where the event(s) were held
- All funds collected MUST to the Nebraska Knights of Columbus Culture of Life Foundation by MARCH 1st, <u>this campaign is not to be used as a</u> <u>council fundraising activity</u>



### ONE ROSE ONE LIFE CAMPAIGN

- Call for Life:
- 1. As a council set a goal of how much you want to raise to support life (i.e. \$2000, \$1500, \$500)
- 2. Have your chairman find 10-20 members (depending on the amount you choose to raise) of your council to "call" family, parishioners, neighbors and friends.
- 3. Divide the call volume equally amongst the council, i.e. if your goal is \$1,000 and you have ten brother Knights making call then each will need only \$100 each, if they raise more then they are extending Gods work



#### ONE ROSE ONE LIFE CAMPAIGN

- 4. During the call secure the donation, gather contact information so that collecting the donated funds can be simplified
- 5. Mail to the donors a current Nebraska Knights of Columbus Prayer Card, donation form and a returned self addressed envelope so the donations can be sent back to councils, once all funds are collected send them to the Knights of Columbus Culture of Life Foundation Nebraska
- Suggested donation forms and call scripts along with a step by step process will be sent to each council to help in this effort



#### **BUCK A MONTH**

- Buck a Month is a terrific and easy way to raise funds for local and state prolife activities
- Mail a Buck a Month form with your yearly dues notices, sample forms can be on the state website
- Collect from participating members of your council \$1 a month (most members usually pay the entire \$12 once a year)
- Send the clearly marked Buck a Month check(s) to the Culture of Life
   Foundation Nebraska by July 1<sup>st</sup>. Once received and recorded you then will
   receive back 50% of your donation to be used for local prolife causes in your
   area
