




- Incentives
 - June 2021-June 2022
 - First Council to reach and maintain 100% of quota - \$1,000
 - One Third of Quota through E-membership
 drawing for \$500
 - All recruiters of 3 new Knights drawing for Hotel Room and 2 tickets to Friday and Saturday Banquets at 2022 State Convention



- Incentives
 - Fast Start
 - July \$100 to any Council at or above 25%
 - August \$250 to any Council at or above
 50%
 - September \$500 split equally between top proposer (and ties) in each region in 1st Quarter.



- Incentives
 - Grow the Order Grow our Faith
 - October Random drawing of 1-\$100 and 1-\$50 from all proposers during month
 - November Random drawing of 1-\$50 and 1-\$25 from all proposers in each region during month
 - December \$500 split equally between all Councils that bring in 50% of quota during 2nd Quarter.
